#### **Required Forms**

These are the conditions you agree to abide with when you choose to play netball with a team from St Mary's Catholic Primary School.

All signed Code of Conducts must be returned to the office by <u>Friday 16<sup>th</sup> of March 2015</u>. <u>Sorry but</u> <u>No late enrolments will be accepted</u>. #### Netball Uniforms

#### <u>Juniors</u>

These uniforms are the property of the school. Naturally, for longevity we want to keep them in the best condition that we can and ask that they are washed and treated with care. So please keep your uniform for game day only. All uniforms will be collected by your coach after the last game, so please bring a change of clothes on that day.

#### NSG SET Modified Uniforms

NSGM are to wear their sports uniform. Being their sports t-Shirt and <u>a royal blue pleated netball</u> <u>skirt (due to no longer having the SKORTS)</u>. Netball WA rules stipulate that you cannot play in shorts and the individual will be unable to participate in the game. <u>Footwear</u>

All players must wear proper sports shoes – no skate shoes, casual shoes, surf shoes etc. This is a by-law of the Association and players will be prevented from playing in inappropriate footwear.

#### UNIFORMS

This year there is a \$20 non-redeemable bond for the uniforms. As we have loaned these out for the last 3 years at no charge, it is becoming more apparent that we charge a fee, as the quality of the uniforms is deteriorating. This is necessary so when the time comes to replace the uniforms, we have already raised the funds for them.

At BNA we have complied with these structural changes and following are the Netball programs and competitions which will be offered in season 2015. Bunbury Netball Association Inc. fees include BNA fee, SWNR fee, Netball WA fee & Insurance. (Inclusive of member insurance)

First Structural change is that all NSG Net Coaches must now have their Foundations Coaching Accreditation or do a NSG training day, believe me quicker to do Foundations and you end up with

an Accreditation, knowledge, program and insurance. Do not fear, we will have this up and running for you and it is not scary at all.

Did you know that as a coach/umpire you need to be affiliated with Netball WA! If you have a fall at training or at the game and you are unable to work, you may be able to make a claim through your NWA insurance. Being a WA netball member also allows you to access endorsed coaching/umpiring courses through Netball WA.

Umpiring (you will be asked online if you want to umpire)

This year with the commencement of our Umpiring Academy we have divided it into colour levels to create pathways. We feel that umpiring is very much all about confidence and understanding of the rules. Umpires knowledge and understanding develops at different rates, therefore we only feel that it is fair to allow someone to re-join a level again till they feel they are ready to take the next step. Adults that would like to learn, please contact us to determine levels.

**Foundation Umpire Program Level Green:** this is a beginners Umpiring Program for **anyone** who is wishing to learn how to umpire. You will start off umpiring NSG players (10 and under) Coaching will be Run by Vikki Merritt on Saturday mornings from 8am – 9.15am, followed by umpiring a NSG Set game at 10.30am. Starting Date Saturday 2<sup>nd</sup> of May (**Minimum age 12**).

Foundations Green – if you have completed a year of Foundations and are not completely confident you can re-enrol in foundations Level Green again.

**Development Umpires Program** – includes levels **Red**, **Blue**, **and White** its aim is to develop their skills/knowledge while having the guidance and support of Badged Umpires.

**Development Red** – 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year post green **First RED Umpiring Coaching Clinic** Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> March from 4.30pm to 4.00pm (next 2 training nights to be TBC)

### Level Red – Criteria for 2015 – Must have satisfactory completed FUP-Green Program with Vikki

- Completed Rules exam on line prior to start of season 2<sup>nd</sup> May (participation only, the score is irrelevant for this level)
- Complete at least 3 our of 4 pre-season sessions. (Which will be the same nights as the members trials)
- The following program (KPI's) will need to be maintained through the season (this criteria will be coached along with more as the umpire progresses): Whistle, Voice, Hand signals and Positioning.
- Protocols to be followed at this level and to be maintained (these will be coached): Meet in middle of court to discuss centre pass and best player, No shooting of goals or using your phone whilst umpiring or quarter breaks. Nails and Jewellery check EVERY GAME.
