



## JOHN WALKER MUSIC SCHOLARSHIP Marist or Mercy Campus YEAR 7 2016

### Purpose of the Award

The John Walker Music Scholarship is in memory of the late Mr John Walker, a former School Principal in the Bunbury Diocese. To honour John and his love of music, the Bunbury Catholic primary schools would like to assist a student develop their own passion for music.

**Students from local Catholic Primary Schools entering Year 7 2016 at Bunbury Catholic College (Marist & Mercy)** are invited to apply for the 2016 John Walker Music Scholarship.

It is a **merit-based** Scholarship given annually. Only students who currently attend a local Catholic Primary School are eligible for this scholarship.

### Scholarship

The Music Scholarship will cover **full music tuition fees** for one year. The recipient is expected to remain in **good standing, contribute to ensembles as directed and portray exemplary behaviour**. The recipient is subject to all of the rules and regulations of the College's Instrumental music policies including instrument hire agreements and attendance.

### Criteria

The John Walker Music Scholarship is made with consideration to the following criteria:

- The student's record of experience and/or outcome of a music aptitude tests
- The student's academic record
- The potential for the applicant to contribute to the quality of the music program

### Obligations

Students receiving Scholarship Awards will be expected to fulfil the academic and artistic responsibilities of the award. These will include good attendance to lessons, involvement in one or more school/community bands and exemplary behaviour and attitude. Students may expect their award to continue for the school year so long as they have lived up to the conditions of the award.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

### How to Apply

Students should submit a **completed application form before Friday 16 OCTOBER 2015**.

There is **no audition** required in the application process, however, a music aptitude test will be completed by each applicant. This test will be held on **Saturday 24 October 2015 at 9.30am at the MARIST Campus**. Students will not be considered unless an application is received and testing is completed.
