Year 4 – Renae advised all went well. Approx. 250 people attended. Left over milk, buns and egg and bacon rolls were donated to the Intown Lunch Centre who passed on their thanks.

Year 6 – Kate advised the catering van was a success and was great to be able to watch children participate. This year's athletic carnival was a friend raiser.

Footy tipping has now finished for the year. Thank you Darren Coulson for organising.

### Agenda Items

- 1. Mel Toia discussed Scholastic and Book Fair. It was explained that the school receive bonus points that can be spent on the school. Mel advised that next year this will all be done online, Kerry Bonser has previously looked after this however with the new system happening Mel is asking if any parent/s would like to take this onboard. Scholastic will come and train you to use the new system and parent/s would need to organise for catalogues be handed out and when orders come in put them in class baskets. Mel advised is happy to discuss with any parent/s who are happy to take this on in 2018.
- 2. Paul discussed letter received by Alison Piacentini. We have been given the opportunity to run a non-alcoholic drink stand on 28<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup> April 2018 for the Geographe Gift. All profits will come to the school and we have to purchase goods and have the stand manned on both days from 9am to 4pm. It was agreed unanimously that St Mary's will take on this project. Rikki has kindly offered to organise as a parent group, not P&F.
- 3. Jo asked if there is a need to do P&F survey for 2018 for students and teachers, advised no. Probably do survey every few years.
- 4. Suzi Larios spoke about the Nature Playground, which hopefully will commence next month. The committee is working very hard behind the scenes. Suzie handed out some plans on how the Nature playground will look, it has been designed so future generations will be able to add to it. Looking at funding for \$10,000. Have had lots of materials donated, also from parents. Paul has applied and received grant from Cristal of \$2,000, South Bunbury Primary has donated \$2,000 (as it will be also asking the Board for some funding. It was suggested and put to the vote that P&F give up to \$5,000 towards the playground so it can commence. This was voted and approved unanimously. We thank Suzie and the committee with all their hard work to get this playground built for our school.

### Other Business

- 1. Paul advised that Dr Ale is doing skin checks at her clinic (Brecken Health Bunbury) and these will all be bulk billed.
- 2. We have handed in approx. 422 sheets for Earn and Learn.
- 3. Was suggested that for the Year 3, 4 and 5 Sacraments that the P&F will fund up to \$100.00, was put to vote and unanimously agreed. It was mentioned that the P&F pay up to \$70.00 for Year 6 graduation cake as per guidelines.
