Parents are reminded that written absentee notes with

signature MUST be provided for all student absences - a legal requirement from the Education Department of WA. Please notify the school by phone call or email if your child will be absent.

When teachers have completed class rolls each morning, the school office will SMS parents for any unexplained/ not notified absences each day.

Students arriving at school late, i.e. after the morning siren, MUST come through the office and be signed in by their parent/caregiver. STUDENTS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO SIGN THEMSELVES IN. Should a student need to leave school early, their parent/caregiver must sign the student out at the office, even though the class teacher may have been notified. Our Duty of Care requires us to account for each student during school hours, 8:45am to 3:10pm.

Remember, even though you have phoned or emailed the school with your child's absence, you must still send a signed note. This is a legal requirement.

KINDERGARTEN 2019

Parents who have siblings due to begin Kindergarten in 2019 are advised to ensure they have submitted their applications for enrolment BEFORE the end of Term 1 2018. Thank you.

MCEETYA DATA FORMS - KINDERGARTEN AND PRE PRIMARY

Kindergarten and Pre Primary Parents are requested to return their completed MCEETYA data forms by Monday 12 February 2018. These were handed out to students on Wednesday 31 January.

PARENTS VISITING DURING SCHOOL HOURS

Parents are reminded that if they visit the school during school hours (including parents assisting in classes and the Canteen), they are required to sign in and sign out at the office. This enables us to account for everyone on the school site in the case of an emergency. Our Duty of Care also requires us to know who is on the school site during school hours.

JEWELLERY

No jewellery may be worn, other than a functional watch, and (if ears are pierced) ONE earring stud or sleeper in BOTH EARLOBES. This restriction is in keeping with school philosophy of reducing the importance of material goods and the risk of injury. Children are not permitted to wear nail polish.

HAIR

Hair should be always neat and tidy and should not reflect the extremes of any current fashion. **Long hair must be kept neatly tied back.** Ribbons or clips **must be** PLAIN white or blue. Matching headbands can be purchased from the Uniform Shop. Hair must be kept at the student's natural hair colour, without artificial hair colour added.


