ABSENTEES

When teachers have completed class rolls each morning, the school office will SMS parents for any unexplained/ not notified absences each day.

Students arriving at school late, i.e. after the morning siren, MUST come through the office and be signed in by their parent/caregiver. Should a student need to leave school early, their parent/caregiver must sign the student out at the office, even though the class teacher may have been notified. Remember, even though you have phoned or emailed the school with your child's absence, you must still send a signed note. This is a legal requirement.
