#### **Plantar Warts**

There has been a number of cases in the school of plantar warts. Plantar warts, officially named verruca warts are caused by a virus. The virus attacks the skin on the bottom of the feet but as well as the palm area of the hands. The virus is transmitted by direct contact, skin to skin and may be picked up more easily if you have an opening or crack in the skin. Please could you check your child's hands and if you are not quite sure, take your child to your doctor as there are treatments available and it will help to prevent the virus spreading to other students in the school.
