Principal's Welcome

Dear Parents, Students and Friends,

I was very fortunate to be part of a group of 15 principals from Catholic schools in WA to spend twelve days in New Zealand working with education and coaching specialists. We visited several schools with some in some fairly tough areas. One of the most powerful messages from the trip was how proud New Zealand people are of their Maori culture. I have come back with a number of new teaching ideas that I will be sharing with staff over time. The damage from the earthquakes that occurred while we were in New Zealand was extensive. We were fortunate enough to have left Wellington on Sunday morning to fly to Auckland, before the earthquake struck that evening. On Tuesday night the St Mary's AGM was held with about 50 people in attendance. We listened to a presentation from Penny and Beth from Headspace who spoke about the importance of mental health and wellbeing, and the assistance Headspace can offer to 12 - 25 year olds. The seven members of the school Board have agreed to stay on into 2017. Chris Gibbs has been the P & F Representative on the Board and will stay on the Board without the P & F duties. Sonja Cahill, Mel Sarre and Naomi Cross have completed their terms on the P & F in the positions of President, Vice President and Secretary respectively and we greatly appreciate the time and dedication they have given to their roles over the years. We have not had any volunteers for the three key P & F roles at this stage. We will also need a parent who is prepared to be the P & F's Board Representative, who reports at Board meetings what has been discussed at P & F meetings. God bless
