Literacy	<p><u>Daily Activities</u></p> <p>Reading 10 minutes reading with an adult. This can be a home reader, a book from home or an online book from Epic Readers. (see instructions below).</p> <p>Sight Words Practise reading aloud sight words and work through lists at your own pace. Parents to test when ready and write date of completion at the top of the page. Sight words booklet located in take home bag.</p> <p>Reading Eggs Log on details are at the front section of the diary. Please work through the 'My Lessons' section. A suggested time frame is 15 minutes a day.</p> <p><u>Additional Activities</u></p> <p>Spelling In your pack you will find a Year 2 Learning from Home booklet. Turn to the first page 'ch, sh, th, wh' Activity Grid. The sounds for the week are ch, sh, th, wh.</p>

	<p>Each day select one activity from the activity grid to complete. Cross out the activity once completed. Complete a minimum of 4 activities throughout the week. You may do additional activities if you wish. All writing tasks to be completed in your 'My Learning at Home Book'.</p> <p>Friday: Complete a spelling test with an adult. Any incorrect words write them three times.</p> <p>Handwriting In your pack you will find a handwriting book. Complete and decorate the front cover. Complete the letters Ll and Tt.</p> <p>My Favourite Book</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Read or have your parents read to you a favourite story. This can be a story you have at home or one you have read as a home reader this week. 2. Write a retell of what happened in the story in your 'My Learning at Home Book'. 3. Draw your favourite part of the story in your 'My Learning at Home Book.' 4. Seesaw Task: Take a photo of your writing and upload to Seesaw.
<p>Mathematics</p>	<p><u>Daily Activities</u> Each student has a mathematics pouch with various activities. Choose one of the activities each day and complete. Activities are designed to be repeated.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Hundred Chart <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Practise counting by 2s, 5s and 10s starting at 0. -Practise counting by 10s off the decade, forwards and backwards. E.g. 3, 13 ,23, 33. -1 more, 1 less, 10 more, 10 less chart. -Play a time or number facts game. <p><u>Stepping Stones</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Click on the link above 2. Scroll down and click on Australia <i>click here to enter</i> 3. Click on Year 2 4. Click on Week 1 5. Religion	<p>Morning, lunchtime and end of day prayer. (Suggestions at bottom of timetable.)</p> <p>Additional Activities</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. View the Beginners Bible Easter Story. 2. Read through the Holy Week Powerpoint (click on the blue link) 3. Draw a picture representing 'Holy Thursday'. (The Last Supper) 4. Watch the Last Supper animation (click on the blue link). <p>Ask students these questions;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Why do we call this Jesus' Last Supper? *How Jesus felt that night? *What he might have been talking about with his friends at the table? *What would you have said to Jesus? *Why Jesus washed the disciples' feet? *Why we celebrate "the washing of the feet" on Holy Thursday <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Draw a picture representing 'Good Friday'. (Jesus on the Cross).

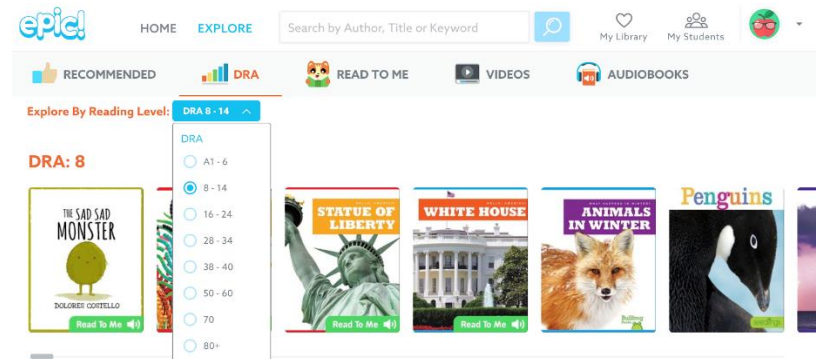
