Literacy	<p><u>Every School Day</u> Read books you have at home. Read for 15 to 25 minutes. AR will go to remote learning from the beginning of Term 2. Details will be sent out on how to access on-line books later.</p> <p><u>Additional Activities. Use Literacy Book</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Find a short book, read for 15 mins. Draw your favourite character. Find out what an adjective is. Write a list of adjectives to describe your favourite character.2. Complete a book review on a book you have just recently read. Look in Seesaw. Mr A has posted a template on how to conduct a book review.3. Choose a book you have read. Draw the beginning, middle and end of your story. Write a sentence explaining each part of the story (beginning, middle and end). Use your school exercise book to work in. Take a photo of your work and See Saw it to Mr A.

Watch the Last Supper animation (<i>click on the blue link</i>). <p>Ask students these questions;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> *Why do we call this Jesus' Last Supper? *How Jesus felt that night? *What he might have been talking about with his friends at the table? *What would you have said to Jesus? *Why Jesus washed the disciples' feet? *Why we celebrate "the washing of the feet" on Holy Thursday <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Draw a picture representing 'Good Friday'. (Jesus on the Cross).
