From the Principal

Dear Parents, Students and Friends,

I hope you had a blessed Easter with your family and are refreshed and ready for all Term 2 has in store for us.

The holidays were somewhat disrupted for several families as well as staff who were impacted by Covid.

There have been significant changes to the Covid guidelines for schools and I had the latest to send to you on Tuesday, when they were already outdated with Mark McGowan's announcement of masks not being required in most places from this Friday including schools.

The good news is that we will be able to run 100 Club tomorrow and we can hold P&F meetings, so we have scheduled our first for Tuesday 3 May at 7pm in the hall. I have a meeting tomorrow morning with other principals and CEWA and I will find other changes will come into play.

Some important information to know is the latest definition of a close contacts:

- a family or household member of a person with COVID-19 who has had contact with them during their infectious period;
- · someone who has had close interaction with a person with COVID-19 during

their infectious period, where they spent more than 4 hours with them in a single day, in a residential setting, including a boarding facility, where masks have not been worn; or

· someone who is directed by WA Health that they are a close contact. Schools are no longer considered close contact venues. A child who attends class with a peer who later tests positive to COVID-19 will no longer be identified as a close contact.

If your child does test positive to Covid, please contact the Health Department, inform the school and complete the details on the school portal.

Swimming Lessons

Swimming lessons started yesterday and unfortunately the large pool has an issue and is not able to be used at the moment. Hopefully it will be repaired for tomorrow. It meant all of our students had to use the smaller pool, but both the swimming teachers and students coped remarkably well with the change. With the relaxation of Covid rules, parents will no longer be restricted to how many times they visit to watch lessons. Please ensure your that names are on all items of clothing used for swimming to make it easier to return them.
