From the Principal

Dear Parents, Students and Friends,

A happy belated Mother's Day to all of our mothers and grandmothers. Our Year 5 students produced some clever caricatures to share with their mums with photos of their art in today's newsletter.

The last two weeks have been extremely challenging for many of our families with Covid cases spiking across the state. Our staff have also been impacted

greatly. I have heard many examples of the St Mary's community helping each other during these tough times which is what makes our community so strong. The State Government has offered RAT tests to schools to distribute to their school communities, but ours haven't been delivered yet. We are working on a plan to distribute them but that depends on when they arrive.

NAPLAN Testing

With so many Covid cases it has made NAPLAN testing more difficult for staff to administer. While most students will have sat their tests by the end of today, there is a catch-up time next week for uncompleted tests.

P&F Meeting

We held our first P&F meeting for the year last week with about 16 parents in attendance. It was refreshing and exciting to be able to make plans for friend and fundraising events again. I called for nominations to be on a committee to help plan an upgrade of playground equipment to replace the dome. We have \$7000 that the community raised from last year's Colour Run to put towards it. Please let me know if you would like to join the group. There will also be a Quiz Night in Term 3 and the P&F are keen to support a visit from an author around Book Week. The wine fundraiser proved very popular last year so there have been calls to run that again. Over \$5000 in Teacher Wish List items were approved for equipment that will benefit students in their classrooms. 
Extra Long Weekend

I would like to remind families that our students will have an extra long weekend with staff having a guest presenter at school on Tuesday 7 June after Monday's West Australia Day.


End of School Day Concern
